Motorless is not an opentype font. For best results, when using the Adobe Creative Suite, use it with your glyph panel open. You will see a lot of special characters that let you make creative combinations quickly.

The "SS" and "LT" combinations have some kerning issues. To fix them, I added proper ligatures to the special characters.
